DOES NOT APPLY TO:

Person who is in possession of a documented medical certificate, duly certified by a panel of 2 Government medical officers certifying that, by reason of his medical conditions, he cannot be vaccinated with a COVID-19 vaccine.

For all admitted C-Care patients, a special tariff will be applicable for the Rapid Antigen test and RT-PCR test only.

Please note that there will be a waiting time for processing of Rapid Antigen and Emergency PCR tests.

For all planned surgeries, we remind you that RT-PCR test should be performed 48 hours prior to your admission and in case of an Emergency, a RT-PCR test will be performed unfortunately at a higher cost.

For a proper cost management, C-Care encourages you to anticipate your RT-PCR test.



In case of high suspicion of Covid-19, C-Care (Mauritius) Ltd reserves the right to ask for a RT-PCR test before allowing access to its medical facilities.

In the event that a patient is not willing to undergo the RT-PCR test, the patient may then be referred to another clinic or hospital.
